Decision & Resolve

Shortly before his death, God's faithful servant Joshua challenged Israel with these familiar words.

"Choose for vourselves this day whom you will serve" (Joshua 24:15). This is a choice we all need to make. Unless a firm and fixed decision is made to faithfully serve the Lord, it will not happen. If we do not completely agree and fully accept the fact that God's will and ways are right and best for us, our service to God will be half-hearted (Col 3:23) and our Christianity will be lukewarm (Rev 3:15-16: 19).

FINISH

Joshua proclaimed, "But as for me and my house, we will serve the Lord." Joshua had made his decision. Motivated by love and reverence for the Almighty, he firmly resolved to faithfully serve Jehovah God. We too need this kind of resolve — "to make a definite and serious decision; to settle the matter" (Webster). We need to settle once and for all whether we will faithfully serve and worship God and our Lord Jesus Christ, or whether we will serve our idols (anything that takes the place of God in our hearts).

"Now therefore, fear the Lord, serve Him with sincerity and in truth, and put away" [your false gods] (Joshua 24:14). Joshua challenges Israel to repent and renounce their false gods. If they are to faithfully serve the Lord, they need to give their idols up completely and have absolutely nothing to do with them. "Now therefore, put away the foreign gods which are among you, and incline your heart to the Lord God of Israel" (v. 23).

Our God will not accept intermittent commitment or half-hearted service. The essence of the law was to "fear the Lord your God, to walk in all His ways and to love Him, to serve the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul" (Dt 10:12). "Let *your* heart therefore be loyal [wholly devoted] to the Lord our God, to walk in His statutes and keep His commandments" (1 Kings 8:61). So, "whatever you do, do it *heartily* [put your heart in it; do it energetically & enthusiastically, as to the Lord and not to men, knowing that from the Lord vou will receive the reward of the inheritance; for you serve the Lord Christ!" (Col 3:23-24).

Joshua's sound and sobering words evidently penetrated the minds of those present and deeply touched their hearts. They responded, "We will also serve the Lord, for He is our God" (v. 18). Realizing that these words are easy to say but difficult to practice, Joshua stressed that this commitment should not be made lightly, but should be considered carefully and deliberately. Again, they responded, "No, but we will serve the Lord" (v. 21). May our sincere and dedicated response be the same. —Terry Schmidt &
