Restoration — Spiritual Renewal



Before the days of Global Positioning Satellites (GPS) and sophisticated electronic devices, if a ship at sea or an aircraft in the sky did not take regular navigational "fixes" to determine its location, it could easily stray off course. The same is true in the spiritual realm. There are many diversions, distractions, and temptations that can get us off-track and put us on a wayward course.

In order to stay "on-track," one must possess an accurate chart with which to navigate and plot a correct course. One must also use a compass to ensure true north, along with sighting landmarks and other navigational aids—including the stars. These are fixed "standards" which one can use to compare the true compass reading with the established bearing on an accurate chart.

Of course, our chart is the Bible—the word of God—our fixed standard. "Forever, O Lord, Thy word is settled in heaven" (Ps 119:89). We are to regularly take navigational "fixes" on where we are in life and compare it to the standard. If there is a detected deviation, we must make the necessary adjustments to correct our course to bring our lives into harmony with the word of God. At times, the "storms of life" (the above mentioned 'diversions, distractions, and temptations') can overwhelm us and drive us far from where we should be. We can get so far off course that we actually lose our bearings, and *could* end up lost. When this happens, we need to make some major changes by turning to the One who can help us.

Finding our way back begins with a repentant, humble spirit. The Lord can work with those who have "a contrite and humble spirit, to <u>revive</u> [restore, renew] the spirit of the humble, and to <u>revive</u> [restore, renew] the heart of the contrite ones" (Is 57:15). Then, "trust in the Lord with all your heart, and lean not on your <u>own</u> understanding [this is probably why you got off course in the first place!]; in all your ways acknowledge Him [the true standard], and He shall <u>direct your paths</u>" (Pr 3:5-6). In other words, God will get you back on course!

We see this dynamic in the life of David who sinned grievously with Bathsheba, lied about it, and then had her husband Uriah killed. With "a broken and contrite heart" he prays, "Create in me a clean heart, O God, and <u>renew</u> a right [steadfast] spirit within me" ... <u>restore</u> to me the joy of Your salvation, and uphold me with Your free [generous] spirit" (Ps 51:10 & 12). When you & I get off-track, we need to follow David's example and "be <u>renewed</u> in the spirit of [our] mind (Eph 4:23).

When we obey God's will in this area, He offers this promise: "But those who wait on [trust in] the Lord, shall <u>renew</u> their strength; they shall mount up with wings like eagles, they shall run and not be weary, they shall walk and not faint (Is 40:31). And then our loving heavenly Father adds: "Keep silence before Me ... and let the people <u>renew</u> their strength!" (Is 41:1). With God's help, and by His strength & guidance, we will be able to stay the course and reach our heavenly destination (Jn 3:16-17; Jn 6:44-45; Eph 2:8-9; Phil 3:20-21; 2 Tim 1:9; Titus 3:5; 1 Jn 5:13).
