Bad Angels

Angels are supernatural heavenly beings created by God for the purpose of worshiping and serving Him (Ps 148:2-5; Col 1:16). They also surround the throne of God (Is 6:1-3), and bring Him honor and glory. "Then I looked, and I heard the voice of many angles around the throne ... and the number of them was ten thousand times ten thousand, and thousands of thousands, saying with a loud voice: 'Worthy is the Lamb who was slain, to receive power and riches and wisdom, and strength and honor and glory and blessing!'" (Rev 5:11-12).

The name "angel" in both Hebrew and Greek simply means "messenger." Although they are "ministering spirits" (Heb 1:14), angels have sometimes appeared in human form as men (Gen 18-19). They are not glorified human beings, but are different and distinct from man (1 Cor 6:3; Heb 1:14). Jesus taught that they do not marry and they do not die (Lk 20:34-36). However, angels do share an unattractive ability with mankind. They can sin and rebel against God.

Angels were created as holy beings (Gen 1:31; Jude 6). But, through time, God's word makes known that some angels fell from their state of innocence (2 Pet 2:4; Jude 6). Scripture does not reveal the time and nor the cause of their fall, but it must have occurred before the fall of man, because Satan was present in the garden tempting Adam & Eve. This, of course, was after Jesus "saw Satan fall like lightening from heaven" (Lk 10:18). And "God did not spare the angels who sinned, but cast them down to hell and delivered them into chains of darkness, to be reserved for judgment" (2 Pet 2:4). The Greek word translated "hell" is *tartarus*, and it refers to "an eternal torment in the deepest abyss of hades."

Jude adds: "And the angels who did not keep their proper domain ["kept not their first estate" - KJV], but left their own abode [habitation], He has reserved in everlasting chains under darkness for the judgment of the great day" (v. 6). The phrase "kept not their first estate" is interesting. It means that these angels strayed from the original purpose for which they were created. This is "apostasy" – a word taken from two Greek words (1) *apo*, meaning "away from" and (2) *stasia*, meaning "stand."

So, to apostatize is to move away from a previous stand. This is exactly what these rebellious angels did when they knowingly and deliberately sinned against God.

Ultimately, these evil angels who are now "reserved in everlasting chains under darkness for the judgment of the great day" (Jude 6), will be thrown into the lake of fire (Rev 19:20; 20:10; 20:15), which has been "prepared for the devil and his angels" (Mt 25:41). This will be the inevitable outcome for all – including men & women – who choose to disobey God in this life and rebel against their Almighty Creator. Like the angels who sinned, they too "shall have their part in the lake which burns with fire and brimstone" (Rev 21:8), where they "will be tormented day and night forever and ever" (Rev 20:10).

But those who have chosen to obey God, and remain faithful in this life, will hear: "Come, you blessed of My Father, inherit the kingdom prepared for you from the foundation of the world!" (Mt 25:34). Now, that's the category you & I want to be in! Amen!
