## Inner Peace ... In a Troubled World



When dealing with the perpetual problems of this difficult life, inner peace can often seem somewhat elusive, if not impossible to experience. This highly desired "peace of mind" is reflected in a liberating freedom from worry, anxiety or other tormenting mental disturbances. It is a tranquil sense of inner calm, contentment and serenity. Many troubled souls are willing to pay top dollar to counselors, psychiatrists, and psycho-therapists in search of this elusive entity.

Those who are in Christ need to be assured that Jesus has promised us this peace. "Peace I leave with you, My peace I give to you; not as the world gives do I give to you. Let not your heart be troubled, neither let it be afraid" (Jn 14:27). But, even for many Christians, this peace often remains something that seems all too remote or even unknown. How do you and I move toward truly experiencing the peace that the Lord promised?

First, we must learn to turn our focus away from our problems and direct it toward the Lord God. "Thou wilt keep him in perfect peace, whose mind is stayed on thee: because he trusteth in Thee" (Is 26:3). The Hebrew word translated "stayed" means "to lean on or rest upon for support." Another key word is "trust." When we learn to place our trust in the Lord, we will lean upon Him for strength and support during difficult times of trial. "Looking unto Jesus, the author and finisher of our faith" (Heb 12:2), will result in perfect (complete) peace and needed rest for our souls.

Next, we must turn to the Word of God to seek the truth (Jn 17:17), and learn His will (Eph 5:17). "For the Lord gives wisdom; from His mouth come knowledge and understanding" (Pr 2:6). Paul reveals that studying the Scriptures brings patience and comfort to the sorrowful soul and instills hope (Rom 15:4). Patience will provide the fortitude, endurance and perseverance needed during the demanding trials of life. The comfort provided by God's word will help put hurting hearts at ease, bring rest to troubled souls, and move those filled

with worry & anxiety towards inner peace. "Great peace have those who love Your law!" (Ps 119:165).

In times of troublesome difficulty and personal struggle, Jesus does not want us to depend on ourselves and "go it alone," He wants us to come to Him. "Come unto Me, all ye that labor and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest. Take My yoke upon you and learn of Me; for I am meek and lowly in heart: and ye shall find rest unto your souls" (Mt 11:28-29). The godly wisdom found in Proverbs 3:5-6 is most applicable here: "Trust in the Lord with all thine heart; and lean not unto thine own understanding. In all thy ways acknowledge Him, and He shall direct thy paths."

Our Lord and Savior recognized that we would experience difficulties and problems in this troubled world. "These things I have spoken unto you, that in Me ye might have peace. In the world ye shall have tribulation: but be of good cheer; I have overcome the world!" (Jn 16:33). Because of "the good pleasure of His will" (Eph 1:5), those blessed souls who are in Christ can experience inner peace in a troubled world. As the Lord Jesus Christ assures our frail & fragile hearts once again: "Peace I leave with you, My peace I give to you; not as the world gives do I give to you. Let not your heart be troubled, neither let it be afraid" (Jn 14:27). — Terry Schmidt &
